

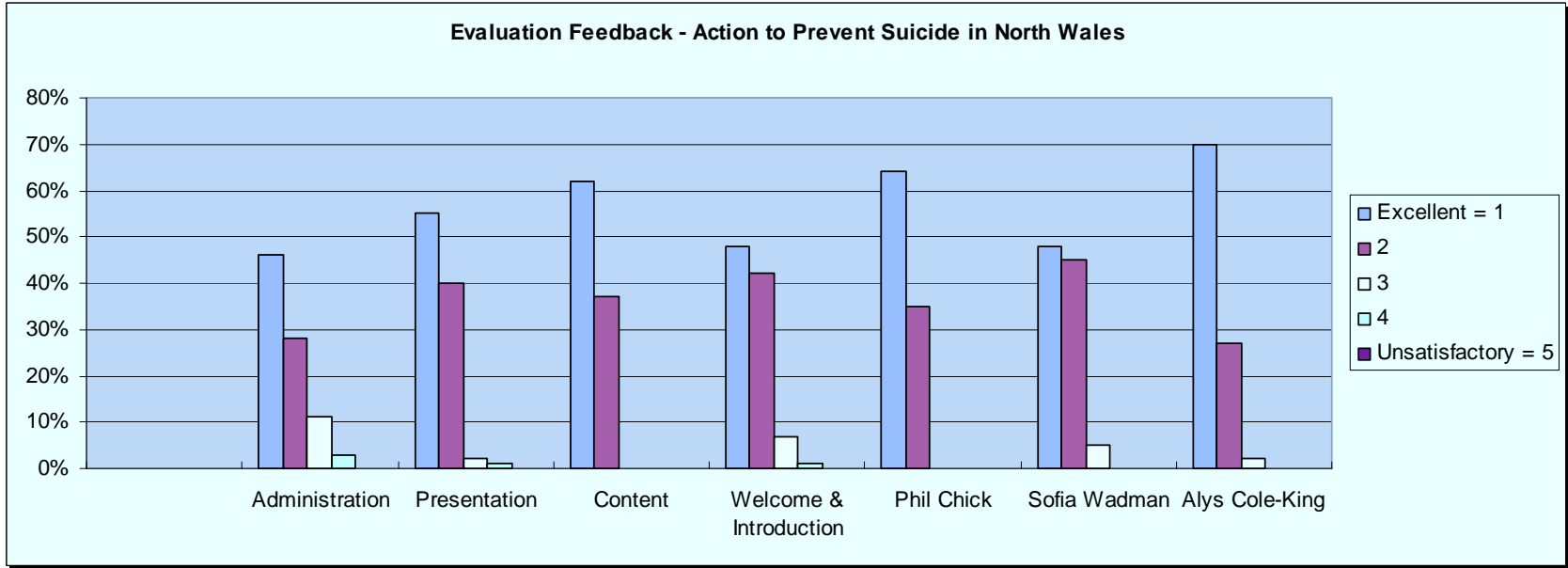

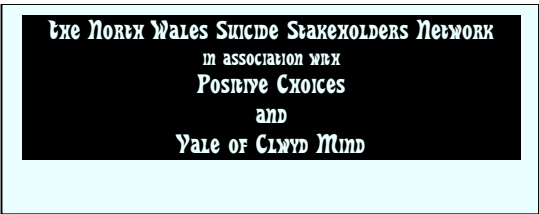

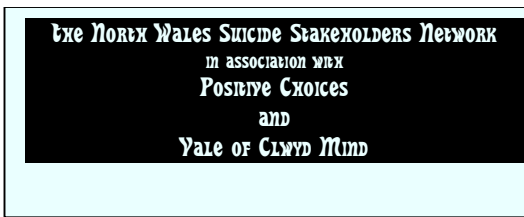


Comments from Evaluation Forms

“There was a good choice of workshops – a shame that we could only do 2”

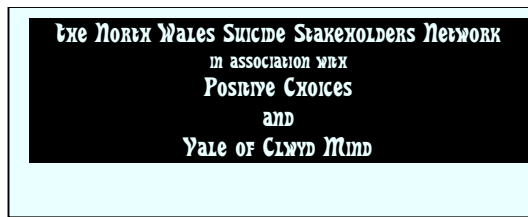
“Informative day with good speakers. Good day for networking. Could this be an annual event please”.
